

## ORGAN DONOR REGISTRY *Fact Sheet*

The Organ Donor Registry (“ODR”) is the way to legally record your decision about organ and tissue donation.

The ODR is the only way to record this decision, and replaces all previous methods such as placing a decal on your driver’s license or Care Card.

The ODR is operated by **BC Transplant**, an agency of the **Provincial Health Authority**. You can contact **BC Transplant** at:

Registration is voluntary. It allows you to state which organs and tissue you want to donate. You can also register that you do not wish to donate any organs or tissue.

You can register with the ODR in one of four ways:

1. Complete the form on-line .
2. Request a brochure by mail by contacting **BC Transplant** (# above).
3. Pick up a brochure from a Driver Service Centre, any London Drugs location, ICBC Autoplan Centres, ICBC Claim Centres, or your doctor’s office.
4. Download and print a hard copy of the form to fill in.

Hospital personnel may access the ODR using a confidential, secure Internet access system which searches by your BC Care Card number.
